

COURSE RULES

- If weather conditions or common sense tells you that conditions are hazardous, take shelter to insure your safety. Restrooms and shelters are located Oaks #6 green Marsh #5 green, Creek #6 tee.
- For player safety and course maintenance, observe and obey all rules and signs.
- Keep carts on paths around all tees and greens.
- Proper golf attire - collared or mock shirts, no jeans and etiquette required at all times, and metal spike are prohibited.
- All players must have their own set of clubs.
- Slow play is unacceptable, keep pace with the group ahead of you.
- Repair all ball marks on greens, rake bunkers and fill divots with sand.
- No alcoholic beverages shall be brought onto or removed from Club Facilities.
- Each golfer assumes all risks and danger incidental to the game of golf and is personally liable for all damage to property or injury to persons which result from golfer's action.

U.S.G.A. RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY EXCEPT WHERE LOCAL RULES PREVAIL

- Water hazards are defined by yellow stakes, lateral water hazards by red stakes, out of bounds by white stakes.
- Play prohibited from environmental sensitive areas, marked by stakes with green tops: play as hazard. When an environmental sensitive area interferes with stance or swing, the player must take relief without penalty. One club length from the nearest point of relief, not nearer to the hole.
- A provisional ball may be played for a ball that may be lost in a hazard. If the original ball is found in the hazard, the player may either play the original ball as it lies, or the provisional ball with a one stroke penalty.
- Drop Zones are designated on Marsh #3 and Marsh #8 for balls entering the water hazard.
- A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only.
