

ROSEDALE'S LOCAL RULES

- The pond side edge of all bulkheads define the lateral water hazard.
- Yellow marked ponds on #3, #10 and #17 are in play as lateral water hazards from the forward tee box (s).
- On #4, play the ball as it lies on the dirt portion of the cart path.
- On #5, if the ball lands in the water hazard by way of out of bounds, there are 3 options: play the ball as it lies, or under penalty of one stroke, play the ball from where the previous stroke was made or use the drop area.
- Waste bunkers #10 (left side), #12 (right), #15 (left & right) and #18 (right).
 - Out of Bounds The road to the right of 1 and 4 and beyond 8 and 10 greens; and any land area across a pond adjoining private property.
- Environmentally Sensitive Areas Located on #4, 5, 12, 13, 14 and 15 may not be entered
 to search for or retrieve a ball. You may stand in the E.S.A. to play a ball not in the
 E.S.A.
 - Special Lateral Hazard Markings On the right side of 14, 15, 17 and the left side of 18, the cart paths are marked with red rectangles. These special markings define the margin of the hazard. If your ball enters the hazard, under penalty of one stroke, relief may be taken on the fairway side of the cart path, no nearer the hole.
